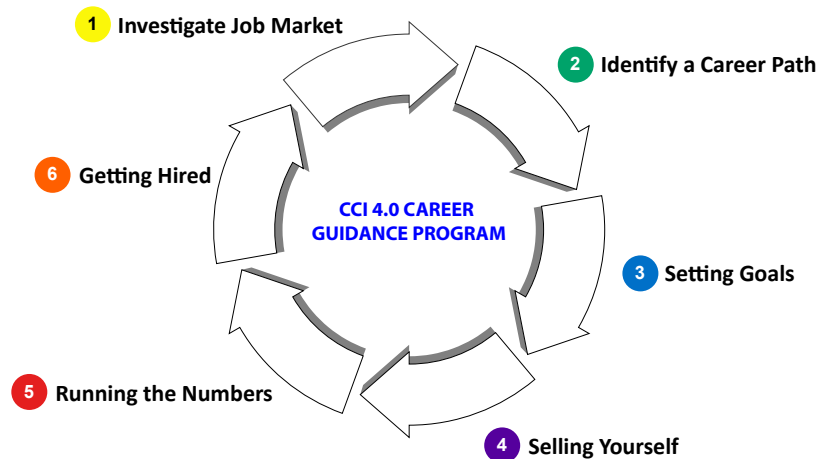

1 INVESTIGATE JOB MARKET
